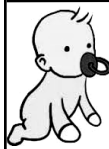

GOT A LITTLE SPARE TIME?



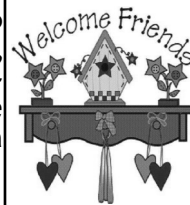

His dream was to save the babies, and to build a church in his village so that they would come to know Christ as their Lord and Savior like he had done. He and his wife had, at that time, adopted 42 Minge babies from his village and had opened an orphanage to help take care of them, so that part of his dream had come true. Building the church was the second step in fulfilling his dream.

OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD



It's almost time to pack a box for Operation Christmas Child. Deadline week is November 12-19. That doesn't give us a lot of time to pick up our little "goodies" to pack in a box. Start with a quality, age appropriate, "wow" item such as a stuffed animal, sports item, baby doll, clothing outfit, etc. that will catch the child's eye when they open the box.

As you shop, **DO NOT INCLUDE:** Candy; toothpaste; gum; used or damaged items; war-related items such as toy guns, knives, or military figures; no chocolate or food; no seeds; fruit rolls or other fruit snacks; drink mixes (powdered or liquid); liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; no snow globes, no glass or breakables, and no aerosol cans.

DO INCLUDE: Comb/brush/toothbrush, washcloths, wrapped bar soap, colorful bandaids, reusable plastic cups/plates/bowls, reusable containers with hair clips/bows etc. in them, blanket, foam balls, puppets, notebooks, pencils/colored pencils/sharpener, crayons, colorbooks/pads, watercolors, stickers, playdough, jump rope, jewelry, toy cars, hats/scarfs/mittens, socks/shoes, plastic tools, plastic dinosaurs/stuffed animals, blocks, shirts, pants, underwear.

So now, make your list and head out to the dollar store and have some fun! You'll be blessed because of your giving. A child will be blessed at the receiving. Each child that receives a box is given a booklet, in their own language, telling them about Jesus Christ. These boxes are allowed into countries that are anti-Christ where missionaries are not allowed to go. Because of the Christmas boxes, many families have been saved. As you pack your little box, pray for each child who receives them. You can also add your picture and mailing information as well as a note to the child.

Please include \$7.00 inside your box for processing and shipping. Thank you for your love and concern for a poor child needing to know the love of Jesus!
