

A TERRIBLE, HORRIBLE, NO-GOOD, VERY BAD DAY (Daniel 8:1-27)

OPENING

God is writing through Daniel to encourage us to trust God when we have terrible times.

He wants us to know He is in control and will turn difficulties into blessings in His perfect way and perfect time.

I. WHAT IS THE MEANING OF ALL OF THIS?

1. God predicted the rise and fall of the Medo-Perisan Empire.

They were a bulldozer overpowering their enemies by overwhelming them with numbers until they reached the Spartans in Greece.

2. He predicted the rise and fall of the Greek Empire under Alexander the Great.

Alexander had one ambition: to take revenge on the Xerxes and the Persians who tried to invade his homeland.

In just four years, the Persian ram was demolished.

But it left Hellenism. (Greek culture, education, language, and engineering saturated the world from Europe to Africa to India.)

3. God predicted the rise of Antiochus IV.

He made it his ambition to wipe out the Jewish religion.

He was the bloodiest, most ungodly man the people of God had ever encountered.

II. WHAT CAN WE LEARN FROM THIS?

- 1. Verse 13 asks the question anyone would ask who's facing a terrible, horrible, no-good, very bad day: "How long?"
- 2. We cannot trust in the kingdoms of this world.

There is no manmade kingdom that is foolproof, that lasts forever.

3. We can trust that God is in control for His purpose and our good.

God ultimately controls or overrules nations and everything in them.
